

Tool Software Update

Required Registration:

Beginning January 2026, tools that ship from the factory will **REQUIRE REGISTRATION BEFORE IT CAN BE USED**. Completing registration will allow for better device management, enhanced Technical Support with faster and more accurate troubleshooting and Service data that can be shared with customers. Below will outline how to use Bartec 365 and TPMS Desktop to register their new Bartec TPMS Tool.

Option 1: Bartec 365 Application

1. Download the Bartec 365 Application (Available on Android and Apple Devices).
2. Launch the application and sign in with your preexisting Bartec credentials or select "Sign up".
 - a. Once signed in, under devices, select the red plus button. Select the device you want to register.
3. Turn on your Bartec TPMS tool, select the language.
 - a. On Bartec 365, then select "Scan for TPMS tools".
4. Within a few moments, Bartec 365 should detect your TPMS tool.
5. Select your tool by Serial Number, and select the region your tool will be used in.
 - a. **NOTE:** Make sure that the serial number matches your Bartec tool.
6. It will then prompt you to connect the tool to Wi-Fi. Select your network and enter your password.
 - a. The option to skip Wi-Fi configuration will be listed below and Wi-Fi configuration can be done later through the tool settings or Bartec 365.
7. To complete setup, your tool will need to download the latest software update. Press "OK".
8. Your tool is now registered, connected to Wi-Fi, and updated with the latest software version.

Option 2: Bartec's TPMS Desktop

1. To register and update your Bartec USA® TPMS tool, please visit <https://tools.bartecusa.com/> and click on download Bartec's TPMS Desktop. Once downloaded, if you do not have a Bartec account, you can select "Create Account" below.
2. Log into Bartec's TPMS Desktop using your credentials and connect the Bartec TPMS tool to the computer via USB.
3. Once connected, Bartec's TPMS Desktop will prompt you to register the tool.
4. Once selected, TPMS Desktop will notify you that the tool has been successfully registered.
5. If your Bartec TPMS Tool is out of date, TPMS Desktop will recognize that there is an update for your tool automatically. Select "Yes" on the first prompt, and "Update" on the second prompt to begin updating your tool.
