Scope of this bulletin:


This bulletin is to inform customer of how to properly remove the OBD cable from the vehicle and tool to refrain from damaging the tool, car, or cable.

1. How to remove cable from vehicle.

When removing the OBD cable from the vehicle it is very important to remove it using the OBD module. Do not remove the OBD connector using the cable, this may damage the Bartec issued OBD cable or the OBD connector on the vehicle. Proper removal is diagramed below.

2. How to remove cable from tool:

When removing the OBD cable from the tool it is very important to remove it using the 16 prong male connector. Do not remove the OBD connector using the cable, this may damage the Bartec issued OBD cable or the Bartec Tool's 16 prong female connecter. Proper removal is diagramed below.
